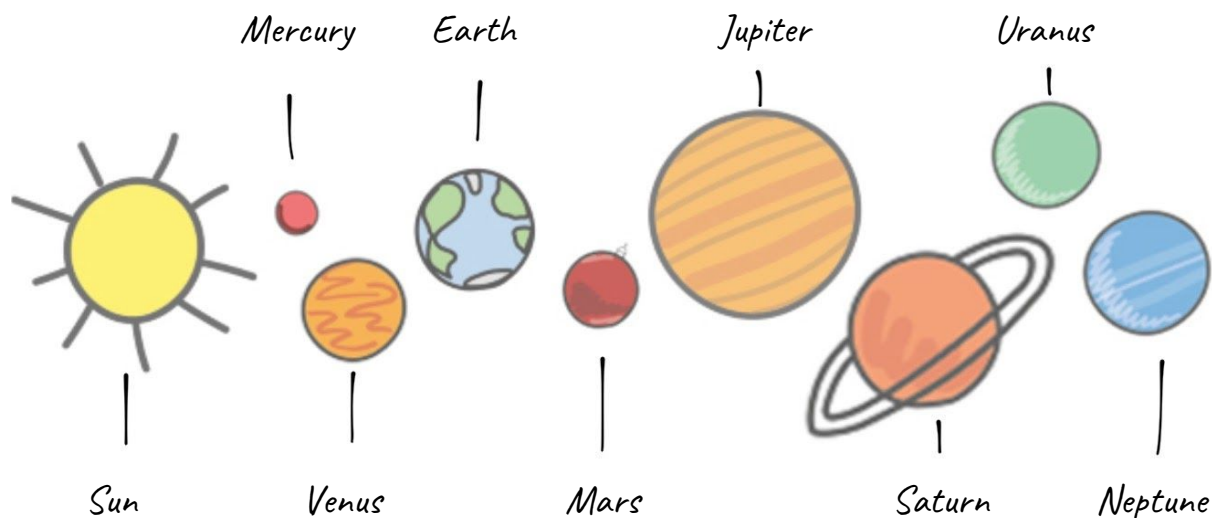


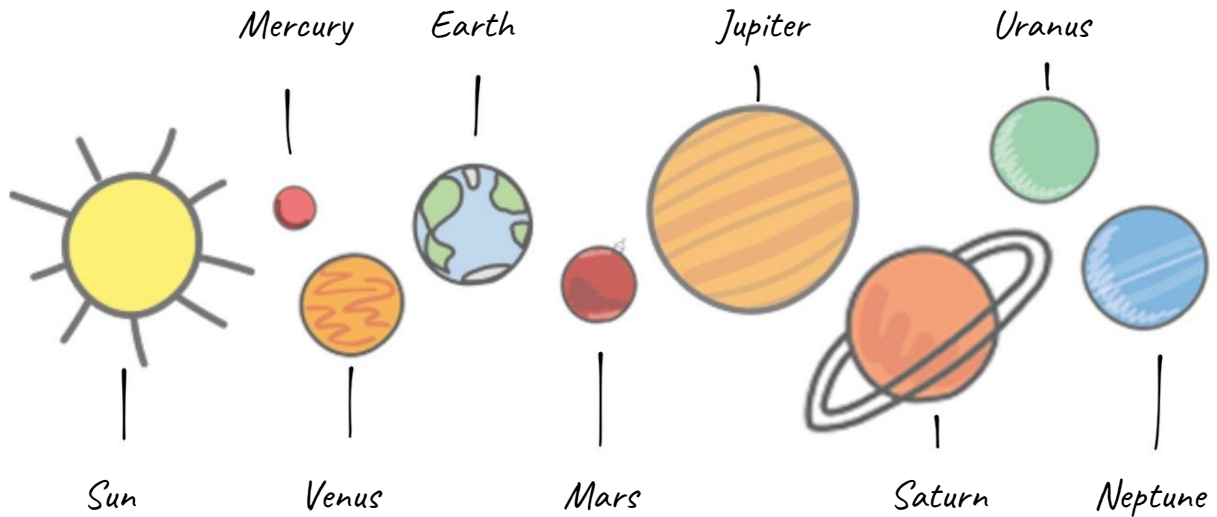
OUR SOLAR SYSTEM



Rule for comparatives and superlative:

Adjectif	Comparatif	Superlatif
Big Ex: Saturn is big	Bigger Ex: Jupiter is bigger	Biggest Ex: The Sun is the biggest
Small Ex: Venus is small	Smaller Ex: Mars is smaller than Venus	Smallest Ex: Mercury is the smallest planet
Hot Ex: Mars is hot	Hotter Ex: Mercury is hotter than Mars	Hottest Ex: The sun is the hottest
Close Ex: Venus is close to the Sun	Closer Ex: Mercury is closer to the Sun	Closest Ex: Mercury is the closest to the Sun
Far Ex: Saturn is far from to the Earth	Farther / Further Ex: Uranus is farther away from the Earth	Farthest / Furthest Ex: Neptune is the furthest
Good Ex: 18/20 is a good grade	Better Ex: 19/20 is a better grade	Best Ex: 20/20 is the best grade
Bad Ex: 05/20 is a bad grade	Worse Ex: 03/20 is a worse grade	Worst Ex: 00/20 is the worst
.....	More (++)	The most (+++)
.....	Less (- -)	The least (- - -)
